BOARD ACTION

Board meets at Annual Convention

The following is a review of the topics discussed and action taken during the Nov. 2 and 5, 2018, meetings of the American Angus Association Board of Directors in Columbus, Ohio.

Topics addressed

Leslie Mindemann, 2018 president of the American Angus Auxiliary, gave an overview of the Auxiliary's activities of the past year.

John Dickinson, recipient of the Angus Foundation's 2018 Young Cattleman's Conference (YCC) sponsorship, reviewed the events and experiences of YCC which took place in June.

The 2018 Annual Report was reviewed.

The Board reviewed correspondence received from members regarding these topics: rule changes, parent verification, transfer fees and genetic defect testing. No action was taken. Staff will respond to the members' inquiries.

Staff reported on National Angus Convention statistics, including 1,866 advance registrations and 421 exhibitors to date. Attendees were present from 43 states and four foreign countries. Main events of the convention schedule were reviewed.

The 2019 Annual Convention of Delegates will be hosted Nov. 4, 2019, in Reno, Nev.

Alan Miller moved, seconded by Dave Hinman, to approve the 2018-2019 meeting dates as proposed. The motion was unanimously approved.

Member and Affiliate Services

The Member and Affiliate Services Committee met via conference call on Oct. 23, 2018, to discuss current and future parentage requirement options. Staff was directed to create a definition of "DNA Marker Typed" for the *Breeder's Reference Guide* to present to the Board.

The following draft defining "DNA Marker Typing" was proposed to the Board:

Parentage Testing effective date Jan. 1, 2019. In the context of parentage testing, DNA Marker Typing means the animal in question has had a blood, hair, tissue, semen, or other biological sample collected, DNA has been extracted, and that extracted DNA has been used to determine the genotype for bovine parentage markers as defined by the International Society for Animal Genetics (ISAG). Extraction and genotyping must be conducted by an American Angus Association (AAA) approved laboratory. This definition applies to any sample submitted on or after the effective date. Furthermore, if the sire and/or the dam of the animal in question has parentage markers on file in the AAA database, the markers from the subject animal and parents have been compared, and parents with parentage markers on file qualify as parents, both individually and as a mating when applicable, to the subject animal.

Mike McCravy moved, seconded by John Pfeiffer Jr., to accept the report of the Committee and the proposed definition. The motion was unanimously approved.

Special Feeder Calf Committee

The Special Feeder Calf Committee met on Oct. 30, 2018, via conference call.

The Angus Link SM marketing certificate has been expanded and now will provide a listing of registered bulls used to sire the enrollment group and will incorporate the Association's "There's more profit with Angus" logo for enrollment groups that are sired by 100% registered Angus bulls.

Staff set a goal for fiscal year 2019 to acquire at least 100 pens of Angus Link "Performance Illustration" data.

Currently, producers enrolling in Angus Link have an option to order up to five additional ear tags for every 100 head enrolled for replacement tags. Staff will continue to monitor this.

Jerry Connealy moved, seconded by Jonathan Perry, to approve the report of the Special Feeder Calf Committee. The motion was unanimously approved.
