Florida Bull Test

84-day report (Nov. 8)

The 2023-2024 Florida Bull Test is hosted at the North Florida Research and Education Center at Marianna, Fla., featuring bulls born Aug. 15-Dec. 31, 2022.

The ration is formulated with a target gain of 3.5 lb. per day. During the first 56 days of the test, the bulls were fed a total mixed ration with grain byproducts and forage. For

the remainder of the test, bulls will receive the same diet in self-feeders, with a slightly reduced amount of roughage and *ad libitum* access to hay.

IBEP Winter 2023 Bull Test Initial report (Nov. 14)

The Indiana Beef Evaluation Program (IBEP) is now conducting its Winter 2023 evaluation. The 125day test features a junior and senior division, and a roughage-based ration targeting 3.25-3.5 lb.

Bulls enrolled in the test were born Oct. 1, 2022, to March 30, 2023.

Nine of the 13 senior division bulls are Angus. All senior bulls weighed an average of 1,016 lb. at the beginning of the evaluation.

The junior division consists of 153 bulls, of which 105 are Angus.

Interim weights will be collected Dec. 12, Jan. 16 and Feb. 13. Final weights will be observed March 17-18, and the 93rd IBEP Bull Sale is set to be hosted April 13.

Manitoba Beef Cattle Performance Ass'n

On-test report (Oct. 28)

The Manitoba Beef Cattle Performance Ass'n is conducting its bull evaluation at the Manitoba Bull Test Station near Douglas, Man., Canada. The test station has been in operation for more than 50 years.

Twenty-two senior Angus bulls are among the 90 bulls on test. Interim weights are scheduled to be recorded Dec. 23, as well as Jan. 20, 2024. The evaluation will conclude with final weights collected Feb. 17-18.

There is also a division of younger bulls, which is scheduled to be weighed on-test Dec. 22-23. Interim weights will be collected Jan. 20, Feb. 17, and March 16. The junior division will be weighed off-test April 15-16.

In addition, the Manitoba Beef Cattle Performance Ass'n is conducting a heifer evaluation featuring 25 heifers, of which five heifers are Angus.

The test sale is set to be hosted March 23.

Tifton HERD Program Report 2 (Nov. 9)

The University of Georgia is also conducting its 2023-2024 Heifer Evaluation and Reproductive Development (HERD) Program at Tifton. The evaluation features 137 heifers representing 23 consignors.

The heifers, born Sept.-Nov. 2022, are being evaluated on performance, reproductive traits and disposition. They will be synchronized and bred by artificial insemination (AI) to GAR Sure Fire, or Baldridge Marksman for heifers closely related to GAR Sure Fire. The heifers are scheduled to be pasture exposed to cleanup bulls beginning Dec. 19.

When interim weights were recorded Nov. 8, the heifers weighed an average of 833 lb. Weights are also planned to be recorded Dec. 11, and final weights will be recorded March 13.

The Tifton HERD sale is planned to be hosted April 16.
