The program seeks to recognize conservation-minded Angus producers and to communicate to others that our industry cares about land, water, wildlife and natural resources.

If you know an Angus producer who qualifies as a true steward of the land, please notify your state Angus association secretary or area conservation agent, or you may submit a nomination and essay yourself. (Producers may not nominate themselves, however.) A nomination form (see page 94) may be requested from the *Angus Journal* office or downloaded from the Internet at [www.angusjournal.com](http://www.angusjournal.com).

One overall winner will be selected by a panel of qualified judges. The winner will serve as a spokesperson for the Angus industry and will be the Association's nominee for the subsequent National Cattlemen's Beef Association (NCBA) Environmental Stewardship Award.

The *Angus Journal* will feature the winner's conservation practices in the November issue. The winner also will be recognized at the 2001 American Angus Association Annual Banquet in Louisville, Ky., on Nov. 12.

Nominations are due into the *Angus Journal* office by **May 15**.
