Nebraska Bull Test 60-day report (Dec. 15)

The Nebraska Bull Test is now conducting its 120-day bull evaluation at Rohde Farms, Mason City, Neb. The bulls, born Jan. 1-March 31, 2020, started on test Oct. 15-16 and will be fed a ration designed for a 3.5-pound (lb.) average daily gain (ADG). Twenty-one ranches have consigned 120 Angus, 10 Red Angus and two SimAngus bulls to the test.

Edisto Forage Bull Test On-test report (Dec. 21)

The Edisto Forage Bull Test is unique in that it is one of the only university-sponsored tests based on grazing only for the entire 168-day evaluation, with no grain or silage added. Conducted at the Edisto Research and Education Center near Blackville, S.C., it features divisions for senior bulls (born Dec. 1, 2020-Jan. 31, 2021) and junior bulls (born Feb. 1-March 31, 2021).

Forty-two Angus bulls are among the 76 bulls being evaluated. Overall, the bulls averaged 709 lb. when weighed on test Dec. 21 after a 14-day warm-up period.

Interim weights will be recorded Jan. 18, Feb. 15, March 15, April 12, and May 10, 2022. Final 168-day weights are scheduled to be recorded June 7, and qualifying bulls will sell in the test sale Oct. 8, 2022.


