#### Strip-till



With the end of October, John Deere offered a new series of striptill equipment,

including a pair of integral models and three drawn models to match dry fertilizer or anhydrous applications.

The new units offer farmers the opportunity to combine nutrient application and tillage into a single, efficient field pass. This has the potential to reduce the need for multiple trips across the field.



"Strip-till can improve soil health, reduce erosion and conserve soil moisture," says Ryan Jardon, marketing manager for John Deere. "Strip-till has been shown to help farmers reduce input costs while maintaining yields and further maximizing their profitability. These new strip-till units give farmers the ability to prepare their seedbeds in the fall, so they're ready to plant in the spring."

The series features the John Deere ST12 and ST16 Integral or the ST12, ST16 and ST18 drawn models that come from the factory ready to work in a variety of soil and field conditions.

No matter the farmer's choice, all models are heavy-built and equipped with a variety of shanks, coulters and row-spacings. Individuals can essentially customize the equipment so it best fits their field conditions and fertilizer needs. In-cab row adjustments are also available.
