NORTH AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK EXPOSITION JR. ANGUS SHOW

Junior Angus exhibitors led 234 entries at the North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE) Jr. Angus Heifer Show Nov. 12 in Louisville, Ky. Andy Musgrave, Pittsfield, Ill., evaluated the 189 owned females and 45 bred-and-owned (B&O) females before naming champions.

Paige Lemenager, Hudson, Ill., led the grand champion B&O female. Lemenager Proven Queen K24 is the June 2022 daughter of PVF Marvel

9185. She first won intermediate champion–division 2 in the B&O and owned divisions.

Deatsman SA Eventress 123-62 won reserve grand champion B&O female. Collin Deatsman, Leesburg, Ind., owns the September 2022 daughter of SCC SCH 24 Karat 838. She first claimed senior calf champion–division 2 in the B&O and owned divisions.

Mercedes Ferree, Sullivan, Ind., led the grand champion owned female. Gohr

Sara's Dream 2020 is a February 2022 daughter of PVF Insight 0129 and first claimed junior champion–division 2.

Core Annie Lu 24K 230K claimed the reserve grand champion owned female. Braylen Schaeffer, Hagerstown, Ind., owns the January 2022 daughter of SCC SCH 24 Karat 838 who first won reserve junior champion–division 2.
