The cattle were measured for hip height to obtain a current frame score (FS) and scanned by ultrasound for a backfat (BF) depth measurement. Bulls were measured for scrotal circumference (SC), and all cattle before entering the ring. All information given to the judges, who also were provided with current expected progeny differences (EPDs).

Big Dry Ranchers Choice 1673 won grand champion in the bull competition after winning the senior division. The April 1991 bull is sired by TC Stockman is owned and is owned by Charles McRae, Jordan, Mont., and Harmon Angus Ranch, Lavina, Mont. Ranchers Choice weighed in at 2, 530 pounds, had 7.3 FS, .76-inch BF, and 45.5-centimeter SC.

The reserve grand champion bull was OSU 6T6 Ultra senior bull calf champion. The September 1992 bull is sired by SS Traveler 6T6. He is owned by Oklahoma State University, Stillwater; Eddie and Karen Parker er, Waurika, Okla. and A Cross Ranch, Eli City, Okla. The bull weighed in at 1,68: pounds, had a 7.4 FS, .28-inch BF, and 38.5 centimeter SC.

This bull was also named grand champion lot in the Angus Sale Bull Show held Thurs. day Jan. 13. Ultra went on to be the top-sell. ing lot in the Angus bull sale, where he sold for \$50,000.

In Friday's 219-jead heifer show, Beartooth Ranch, Columbus, Mont., exhibited the grand champion. BT Bronwyn 175B is the name of the grand winner that first topped the junior division. The March 1992 heifer is sired by R&J Maxima. She weighed in at 1,622 pounds, had a 7.2 FS and .56-inch BF.

YR Montana Lass 41B was named the reserve grand champion heifer and first won reserve honors in the junior division. The March 1992 heifer is sired by Leachman Discovery and is owned by Three Rivers Angus Farm, Roanoke, Ind. and Eaglestone Farm, Carlisle Ky. She weighed in at 1,558 pounds, had a 7.4 FS, and .32-inch BF.




