# **National** Western Angus Show **Draws Record Entries**

ngus breeders from across the United States and around the world gathered Jan. 10-13 for the 1996 National Western Stock Show Super Roll of Victory(ROV) Angus Show in Denver, Colo.

A record-breaking 363 entries were paraded for lead judge Gary Dameron, Lexington, Ill., and associate judge Doug Hixon, Laramie, Wyo., during the two days of Angus shows.

Dameron and Hixon touted it as the best and most competitive Angus exhibition they had seen in their lifetimes. They were impressed with the quality, usefulness and soundness of the heifers and bulls shown.

"I believe we've reached a point where our breed has matured," Dameron said. "The cattle exhibited here are on the right track. They have available performance data and possess a combination of balanced traits. Contrary to popular belief, show ring competition is not dead."

WK Sadie was selected grand champion from the 254 heifer entries in the competition. The February 1994 daughter of Leachman Right Time was first named junior champion. She is owned by Whitestone Krebs, Gordon, Neb., and Nick Wagner, Lafayette, Ind.

Reserve grand champion female laurels were awarded to VAR Forever Lady 4304. Vintage Angus, Modesto, Calif., exhibited the March 1994 reserve junior champion heifer sired by GDAR Executive 727.

Sedgwick's Dividend 4174 collected his third Super ROV grand champion title in the 109-head bull competition. The March 1994 son of TC Dividend 963 first won the junior division. He is owned by McCurry Brothers, Sedgwick, Ran.; Black Wave, Middletown, Md.; and Middlefield Farms, Ft. Collins, Colo.

WK Status walked away with reserve grand champion bull honors. Whitestone Krebs, and TS Farms, Holdrege, Neb., exhibited the March 1994 son of CH Stacker 7040. He first won reserve iunior bull champion.
