

Sale Bulls Average \$4,903

The Angus "Sale Bull" Show and Sale were conducted Jan. 11 at the National Western Stock Show (NWSS) in Denver, Colo. The 58 entries were evaluated by a panel of five judges, including Brad McCurry, Mount Hope, Kan.; Troy Thomas, Onida, S.D.; Roland Starnes, Prattville, Ala.; Kelly Schaff, Saint Anthony, N.D.; and Dru Uden, Franklin, Neb.

The judges named SBH Escalade 9099, the junior division winner, grand champion sale bull. The March 1999 son of Connealy Kincaid was consigned by Tracy Harl, Hastings, Neb.

G13 Stockman 9122, a March 1999 son of TC Stockman 365, was named reserve champion sale bull after first winning reserve junior champion. He was owned by Greg Smith, Elida, N.M.

After the show, the audience was allowed to enter the showing to evaluate the bulls at close range prior to the sale the same afternoon.

The 58 lots grossed \$284,400 for an average of \$4,903/lot.

Hastings Double H Angus, Niobrara, Neb., purchased two-thirds interest in SBH Escalade 9099, the grand champion, for \$25,000.

Milo Rypkema, Rapid City, S.D., and Hugh Ingalls, Faith, S.D., purchased two-thirds interest in the reserve grand champion bull, G13 Stockman 9122, for \$15,000.

At \$28,000, the high-selling lot was APS Stock Traveler, the intermediate champion. Wilson Cattle Co., Cloverdale, Ind.; and Anne Patton Schubert, Taylorsville, Ky., consigned the bull. He was purchased by a syndicate of buyers, including Circle A Ranch, Iberia, Mo.; Express Angus Ranch, Yukon, Okla.; Kiowa Creek Ranch, Elbert, Colo.; Oak Hill Farm, Farmville, Va.; Craig and Ron Byroad, Wolcott, Ind.; Maschino Farms, North Vernon, Ind.; and Zarecor Farms, Newbern, Tenn.

Other high-selling lots:

- Broken Arrow Poncho E06 was consigned by Broken Arrow Angus Ranch, Lincoln, Calif. The Ankony Angus Corp. Inc., Omega, Ga., purchased two-thirds interest for \$24,500.
- Riverbend Powerline 0050, the late spring bull calf champion, was consigned by Riverbend Ranch, Idaho Falls, Idaho. Hamilton Farms and Browarny Photographics, both of Calgary, Alberta, Canada; K-Deen Angus, Wetoskiwin, Alberta, Canada; and Pat Fullam, Dublin, Ireland, purchased two-thirds interest for \$20,000.
