Wisconsin BIA Bull Test

35-day report (Jan. 8)

The Wisconsin Beef Improvement Association (WBIA) has conducted and overseen a central performance bull test each year since 1957. Young beef bulls from all over Wisconsin and the Midwest have been delivered to the University of Wisconsin–Platteville Farm to develop a performance proof in an unbiased environment designed to let the cream rise to the top. More than 5,000 bulls from more than 250 consignors have been tested.

A total of 122 bulls, 83 of them Angus, were delivered Nov. 6, 2017, for the 2018 WBIA Bull Test to go on test Dec. 4-5, 2017. The 100-day test is for bulls born Jan. 1-April 15, 2017.

Bulls are fed a soy- or oat-hull-based ration adjusted with locally available ingredients in a ration designed to promote lean efficient growth while providing adequate energy to allow individuals to express their genetic potential. At the test's conclusion, bulls are ultrasound-scanned for carcass traits and evaluated for breeding soundness.
