65-day report (Feb. 7)

Forty-nine Angus bulls were among 92 total delivered Nov. 5 to the University of Wisconsin

Platteville Pioneer Farm for the Wisconsin Beef Improvement Ass'n (WBIA) Central Bull Test. This year's test (began Dec. 3-4) features bulls of six breeds consigned by 22 breeders.

Bulls are being fed a roughage-based total mixed ration (TMR) for the duration of the 100-day test. Balanced to provide 0.54 Mcals of energy per pound of feed, 50% of the total dietary nutrients (TDN) is derived from corn silage and hay. The bulls are given *ad libitum* access for a targeted ADG of 3.2 lb.

To be eligible for the test, bulls had to be born between Jan. 1 and April 15, 2018.

Group 2, featuring the remaining Angus bulls, Salers, Simmentals, South Devon and Hereford, went on test Nov. 5-6. Final weights were taken March 5. All bulls were efficiency tested for a 49-day test using a GrowSafe System within the 120-day performance testing period.
