Dixie National Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show

Angus breeders led 72 entries at the 2021 Dixie National Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show Feb. 14 in Jackson, Miss. Blake Boyd, May's Lick, Ky., evaluated 56 females, 15 bulls and one cow-calf pair before choosing the winners.

EXAR Fundamental 9186B earned grand champion bull honors. Express Angus Ranches, Yukon, Okla., owns the January 2019 son of Deer Valley Growth Fund. He first claimed junior champion.

Seldom Rest Express 0105 was selected as the reserve grand

champion bull. Seldom Rest Farms, Niles, Mich., owns the July 2020 son of Conley Express 7211. He earlier claimed junior calf champion.

208 was named grand champion female after first winning late junior calf champion. Chancee Clark, Muldrow, Okla., owns the April 2020 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153.

Suter Clark, Gretna, Va., led the reserve grand champion female. Seldom Rest Sandy 9080 is a May 2019 daughter of EXAR Classen 1422B. She earlier won intermediate champion.

Brandon Weber, Alachua, Fla., owns the grand champion cow-calf pair. SFG Tiffany 1317 is a January 2017 daughter of EXAR Classen 1422B. A January 2021 heifer calf sired by Silveria's S Sis 2353 completes the winning pair.

Seldom Rest Farms won breeder's best six head.
