The Clemson University Edisto REC Heifer-development Program uses the latest in precision ag livestock technology combined with genomic testing to develop a group of heifers backed by data. The program features heifers born Sept. 1, 2020-Jan. 31, 2021.

When interim weights were collected Feb. 10, the heifers weighed an average of 780 lb.

In addition to gains, the heifers will be evaluated for disposition, hip height, reproductive tract scores and pelvic area. The 136 heifers in the current evaluation will be synchronized and bred by timed artificial insemination (AI), followed by pasture exposure to cleanup bulls. Only heifers determined to be bred will sell in the sale Oct. 8, 2022.
