

# Amigo, Louise Reign

**J**udge Bill Conley, Clarksdale, Mo., evaluated 200 head at the Western National Angus Futurity Roll of Victory Super Point Angus Show April 28-30 in Reno, Nev. The show included 143 female entries and 57 bull entries.

TJ Amigo V615 was named grand champion bull after first winning the junior division. The Feb. 1999 son of TC Stockman 365 is owned by TJ Cattle Co., Columbus, Mont.; and Suburban Home Farm, Spencer, Ind.

Reserve grand champion bull, WC Northern Edge OC04, first won the title of early junior calf champion. He is a Jan. 2000 son of Northern Improvement 4480 GF owned by Willy Couch, Yukon, Okla.; Hamilton Farms, Calgary, Alberta, Canada; and Laflin Ranch, Olsburg, Kan.

In the female show, Five Star R25 Louise 9045 claimed the grand champion and intermediate champion honors. The May 1999 daughter of TC Stockman 365 is owned by Ryan Nelson, Wilton, Calif.; and Tres Hojas, Buenos Aires, Argentina.

WK Arkdale Pride 9353 won reserve grand champion female after first winning the junior division. Owned by Monarch Farm, Folsom, La.; Whitestone-Krebs, Gordon, Neb.; and Express Angus Ranch, Shawnee, Okla., the Feb. 1999 daughter of WK Latitude was shown with a Feb. 2001 daughter of Bon-View New Design 1407 at side. The duo was named champion cow-calf pair the following day.

Winning reserve grand champion cow-calf pair was G13 Delia 8339, by Michael Banner, College Grove, Tenn. The Nov. 1998 daughter of TC Stockman 365 won the senior division in the open female show. Her calf is a Nov. 2000 daughter of Famous 7001.

TC Stockman 365 sired the winning get-of-sire entry, which was exhibited by TJ Cattle Co., Columbus, Mont. Northern Improvement 4480 G5 sired the winning junior get-of-sire entry, which was exhibited by Express Angus Ranch, Shawnee, Okla. Whitestone-Krebs, Gordon, Neb., exhibited the best six head entry.

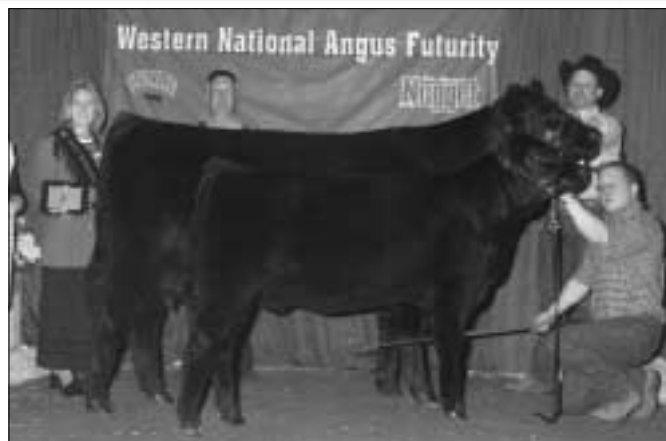

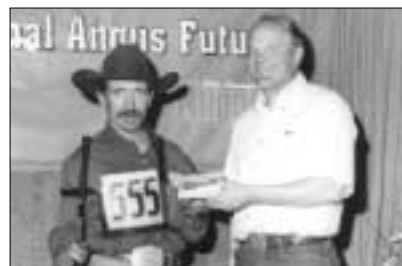
