BDRCT announces upcoming test

The Beef Development and Research Center of Texas (BDRCT) soon will start its next 112-day all-breeds bull test at the facility in Washington.

Bulls eligible for the test are those born between Aug. 1 and Dec. 31, 1999. The receiving dates will be July 13-17. The test will begin Aug. 9 and conclude Nov. 29.

A forage-based ration will be fed, and bulls will have access to large grass traps. Breeders will receive information on average daily gain (ADG), weight per day of age (WDA), adjusted ribeye area (REA), fat thickness (FT), marbling, hip height and









scrotal circumference (SC). All bulls in the top 70% of their breed will be eligible for sale in February 2001.

Test coordinators recommend that each bull be weaned at least 30 days prior to delivery and be properly vaccinated. For more information, call Craig Hillert at (936) 878-2749 or see *www.bdrct.com* on the Web.
