## Western Regional Jr. Angus Show

Junior Angus members traveled to Reno, Nev., to compete in the Western Regional Jr. Angus Show April 17. Mark Johnson, Orlando, Okla., evaluated the 72 owned females, 25 bred-and-owned females, seven bred-and-owned bulls, one cow-calf pair and 13 steers before selecting champions.

Kathryn Coleman, Modesto, Calif., led the grand champion bred-and-owned female, SR SRF Lucy 0062. The April 2020 daughter of EXAR Classen 1422B first won late junior calf champion.

C4 Sandy 805 won reserve grand champion B&O female for Dalton Chambers, Tenino, Wash. She's a July 2020 daughter of PVF Surveillance 4129, and first won summer calf champion.

Suter Clark, Gretna, Va., showed the grand champion owned female that also claimed intermediate champion. Seldom Rest Sandy 9080 is a May 2019 daughter of EXAR Classen 1422B.

EXAR Frontier Gal 1400 captured reserve grand champion owned female. Kynlee Dailey, Kingston, Okla., showed the February 2020
