Western Regional Jr. Angus Show

Junior Angus members traveled to Reno, Nev., to compete in the Western Regional Jr. Angus Show April 15. Kyle Perez, Nara Visa, N.M., evaluated the 91 owned females, 23 bred-and-owned (B&O) females, 12 B&O bulls, four cow-calf pairs and seven steers. John Toledo, Visalia, Calif., evaluated the 20 Phenotype and Genotype females before selecting champions.

Sydney Johnson, Orlando, Okla., led the grand champion B&O female, J&J Frontier Gal 570. The December 2020 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153 first won senior heifer calf champion.

Bar S Pride 123 won reserve grand champion B&O female for Jayce Dickerson, Paradise, Kan. She's a June 2021 daughter of Silveira's Forbes 8088 and first won summer calf champion.

Lauren Frederick, Hutchinson, Kan., showed the grand champion owned female that also claimed junior calf champion—division 1. Conley Sandy 1391 is an April 2021 daughter of Conley Express 7211.

EXAR Frontier Gal 5261 captured reserve grand champion owned female. Sydney Johnson showed the January 2021 daughter of Dameron First Class that first won junior calf champion—division 2.

John Allison, Yukon, Okla., led the grand champion cow-calf pair. EXAR

Princess 1889 is a September 2019 daughter of Dameron First Class. Her January 2022 heifer calf sired by C&C Intuition 7104 is at side.

Taylor Olson, Madras, Ore., led the reserve grand champion cow-calf pair. McCoy Blackbird 9961-5523 is a September 2019 daughter of Leachman Saugahatchee 3000C. A September 2021 bull calf sired by Prairie Pride Next Step 2036 is at side.

Conley Ransom 1810 received grand champion B&O bull for Case Conley, Sulphur, Okla. He is the April 2021 son of Conley No Limit.

Fallon Gohr, Madras, Ore., showed the reserve grand champion B&O bull. Gohr All in 1029 is a March 2021 son of KR Casino 6243.

Conley JR 1229 received grand champion steer honors for Case Conley. He's a February 2021 son of Conley No Limit.

Greta Rosenhagen, Cheney, Kan., showed the reserve grand champion steer. Sankey's Chip 116 is a May 2021 son of EXAR Blue Chip 1877B.

Kathryn Coleman, Modesto, Calif., showed the grand champion female in the phenotype and genotype portion of the show. K Bar D Wendy 13H is the February 2020 daughter of Stevenson Turning Point and first won division 4 champion.

Sydney Rylaarsdam-Schoo, Grangeville, Idaho, led the reserve

grand champion female in the phenotype and genotype portion of the show. Sankey's Everelda Entense 112 is the May 2021 daughter of Silveira's Forbes 8088. She first claimed division 1 champion.

Express Angus Ranches, Yukon, Okla., won premier breeder. Premier exhibitor and premier junior breeder were awarded to Jayce Dickerson.
