The American Angus Association and its members have gone through many changes in the last 25 years. Various sizes of Angus operations are represented by the membership.


"We often hear how small-scale producers are insignificant and they do not matter," says Jerry Cassady,

CATTLE NUMBERS BY HERD SIZE


