Wisconsin Angus Ass'n Preview Show

Angus breeders led 65 entries at the Wisconsin Angus Ass'n Preview Show, June 7, in Jefferson. Dale Hummel, Cabery, Ill., evaluated the entries before choosing the winners.

Hill Valley Reckoning 931 was selected as the grand champion bull. Samuel Henderson, East Troy, owns the May 2019 son of Young Dale Believe 46B. He first won intermediate champion.

KF Alchemist 192 was selected as the reserve grand champion bull. Walridge Farms, Williamsburg, Iowa, and Mackenzie Knutson, Ridgeland, own the February 2019 son of 5T Power Chip 4790. He earlier claimed junior champion.

HBL Lady Replay 9061 was named grand champion female. Ava Leibfried, Belmont, owns the May

2019 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153. She first claimed intermediate champion.

Clayton Walsh, Lyndon Station, led the reserve grand champion female. Cherry Knoll Elisha 1914 is an April 2019 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153.

LW JJ 914 was selected as the reserve grand champion steer. Hailey Jentz, Belmont, owns the May 2019 son of SAV First Class 0207.

Henning Burgess 9089 was selected as the grand champion Angus futurity heifer at the Wisconsin Angus Futurity Show held in conjunction with the Wisconsin

Angus Ass'n Preview Show. Clara Henderson, East Troy, owns the May 2019 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153. She also won reserve intermediate champion in the preview show.

CLF Belle 138F was selected as the reserve grand champion Angus futurity heifer at the Wisconsin Angus Futurity Show held in conjunction with the Wisconsin Angus Ass'n Preview Show.
