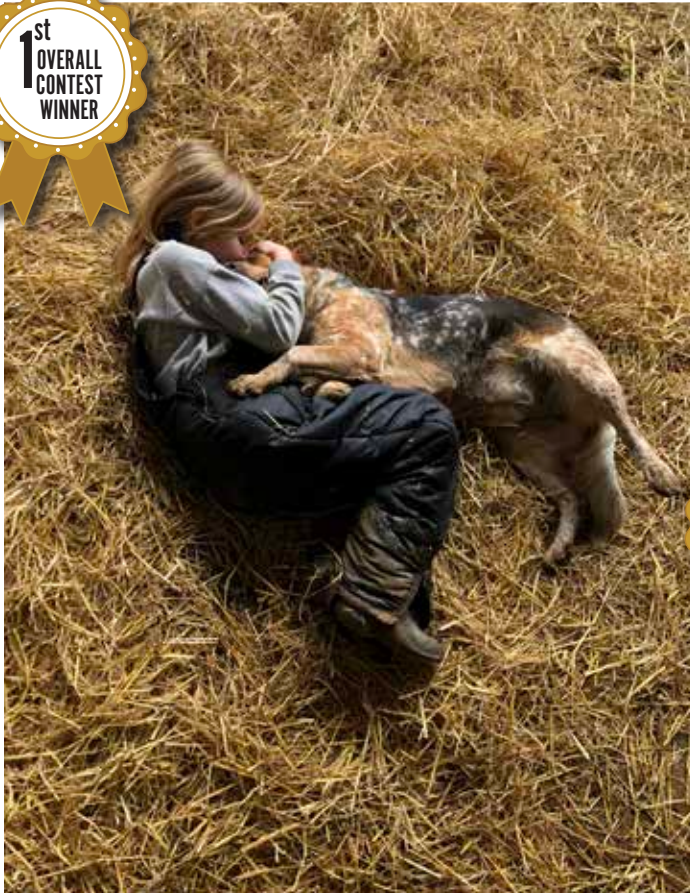


# Worth a Thousand Words
