BRED AND OWNED FEMALES

Junior Angus exhibitors led 249 heifers in the bred-and-owned (B&O) show at the NJAS July 14. Charlie Boyd, May’s Lick, Ky., judged the B&O show, assisted by his son, Blake Boyd, before selecting the top five champion females.

Kyra Meyer, Blue Hill, Neb., exhibited the grand champion B&O female, KGM Elsa 1993. The December 2019 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153 claimed the title of senior champion before making it to the final drive.

J&J Frontier Gal 570 claimed the

title of reserve grand champion B&O female. The heifer, exhibited by Sydney Johnson of Orlando, Okla., is a December 2020 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153. She won late calf champion prior to securing her reserve grand champion title.

Securing third overall B&O champion female was Brady York, Palestine, Ill., with York Farms Rosie 2048. The May 2020 daughter of TGM Compton 1738 won intermediate champion before competing in the drive.

The fourth overall B&O champion

female was shown by Madison Collison, Rockwell City, Iowa. Collison Georgina 050 is a February 2020 daughter of Colburn Primo 5153. She first claimed the title of early junior champion.

KR Miss 0330 secured the title of fifth overall B&O champion female. Payton Scott, Gordon, Neb., owns the February 2020 daughter of PVF Insight 0129. She was first named reserve early junior champion.

Six hundred and fifty-nine head of owned Angus females were exhibited by juniors July 16-17 at the NJAS. Greg McCurry, Sedgwick, Kan., judged the entries and was assisted by Frank Jackson, Mitchell, SD.

Madison Cox, Eagle Point, Ore., exhibited Dameron Lucy 9193, the grand champion owned female. The September 2019 daughter of PVF Insight 0129 won the early senior champion title before entering the grand drive.

Forever Lady 226H secured the

title of reserve grand champion owned female. She owned by Sara Sullivan, Dunlap, Iowa. The February 2020 daughter of SCC First-N-Goal GAF 114 first won junior champion-division 4.
