

LOUISVILLE SHOW LAUNCHES SEASON

The Futurity. Louisville. Traditionally it's the event that kicks off each show season, providing Angus breeders with an opportunity to preview many of the animals that will be showing throughout the country during the coming year.

Officially, it's called the American Angus Breeder's Futurity, and the 32nd one was held July 30-31 in Louisville, Ky. John Maurer, Spring, Texas, judged the show, selecting the Futurity's champions from among 78 females and 39 bulls.

Prior to the show, all animals were measured and the results (printed with this report) provided show spectators with each animal's height both at the withers and the hip, each animal's length from withers to tail, and the fat cover on each animal. Each bull was also weighed.

The culmination of the 2-day show was judge Maurer's selection of supreme champion—PS Power Play. This 1977 son of Early Sunset Emulous 60E, exhibited by Pennsylvania State University, University Park, Pa.; McKean Bros., Mercer, Pa.; Butch Meier, Jackson, Mo.; and Summitcrest Farms, Summitville, Ohio, was the grand champion bull as well as the senior champion.

The reserve grand champion bull and junior champion General JJ Patton, a March 10, 1978, son of Briarhill JJ, was shown by Hicks & Patton, Union Springs, Ala.; New Melleray Abbey, Dubuque, Iowa; and R&J Ranch, Briggs, Texas.

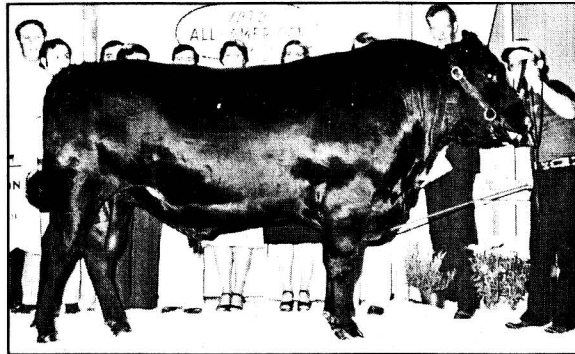
Grand champion female was junior champion Blackbird 842J of Sayre, a Feb. 15, 1978, daughter of Ankonian Dynamo exhibited by Sayre Farms, Phelps, N.Y.

Reserve grand champion female and reserve junior champion was an entry of Weaver Angus Farm, Peoria, Ill., WAF Eileenmere Lass 824, a March 14, 1978, daughter of Eileenmere Lad 522.

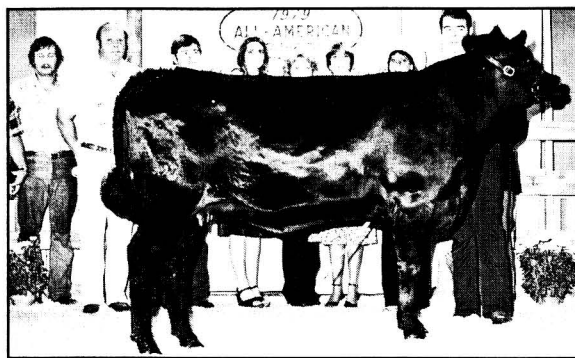

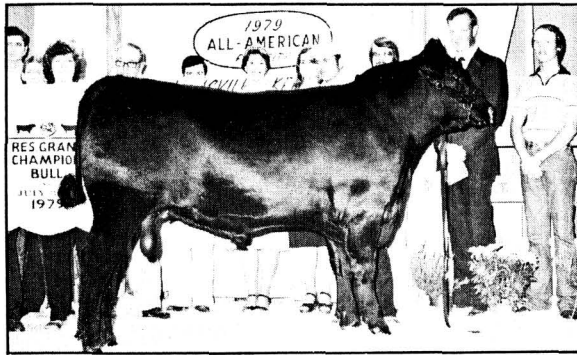
Briarhill won the best six head award and was also named premier breeder and premier exhibitor.

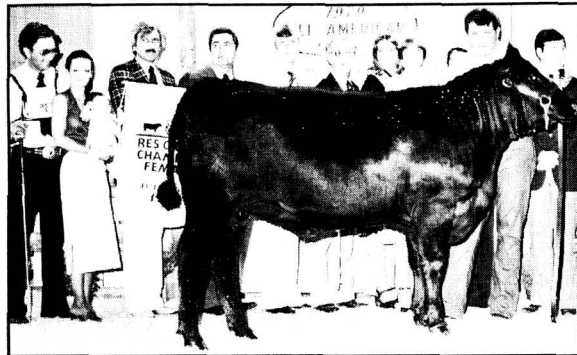
The Robert L. Asher Memorial Trophy went to Brian Haas of Haas Angus, LeRoy, Ill., the show's most outstanding herdsman.
