Calhoun Bull Evaluation 28-day report (Aug. 18)

Bulls were weighed on test July 22 following a 21-day warm-up period for the University of Georgia Calhoun Bull Test. To be eligible for the 112-day test, bulls must have been born between Sept. 1 and Nov. 30, 2019.

IBEP Summer 2020 Bull Test 91-day report (Aug. 18)

32 bulls were delivered April 28 to the Feldun-Purdue Ag Center near Bedford, Ind., for the Indiana Beef Evaluation Program's (IBEP's) summer 2020 bull test. The bulls were born between May 1 and Oct. 31, 2019, and are being fed a forage-based diet with a target gain of 3.25 lb. per day.

Going on test the 18 Angus bulls averaged 730 lb., and all 32 bulls averaged 733 lb.

On-test report (Aug. 11-12)

The 2020 Florida Bull Test is hosted at the North Florida Research and Education Center in Marianna, Fla. The test features bulls born between Aug. 15 and Dec. 31, 2019, with a limit of 132 bulls. Bulls will be fed for a target gain of 3.5 lb. per day to allow expression of growth potential and development.

The bulls were delivered July 21 and weighed on test Aug. 11-12. The 31 Angus bulls averaged 943 lb., and

all 103 bulls averaged 900 lb.

bulls were born Jan. 15-April 15, 2020. Delivery of the bulls is scheduled for Oct. 1, and on-test weights will be recorded Oct. 22-23. Interim weights are scheduled to be recorded Dec. 17, and final weights Feb. 11-12, 2021. The Kirkwood sale will take place April 9, 2021.

The Knoxville Test will be hosted at the Werner Feed Efficiency Testing Center, Diagonal. The 112-day test will feature bulls born Feb. 1-May 2, 2020. Bulls will be received Oct. 21, and initial weights will be recorded Nov. 11-12. Interim weights are scheduled to be recorded Jan. 13, 2021, and final weights will be recorded March 17-18. The Knoxville bulls are scheduled to sell April 23.
