

American Royal Names Winners at 102nd Intercollegiate Livestock Judging Contest

American Royal Intercollegiate Livestock Judging Contest

Oct. 26, 2002 • Kansas City, Mo.

A total of 21 teams comprised of 97 contestants, representing colleges and universities from across the United States, competed for top honors in the 102nd Annual American Royal Livestock Judging Contest held Oct. 26, 2002, in Kansas City, Mo.

Student teams competed in the judging of beef cattle, sheep and swine, and presented orally the reasons for their placings. Winners were announced at the 57th annual awards breakfast sponsored by the Belles of the American Royal (BOTAR) on Sunday, Oct.

27, at the Hilton Garden Inn in Kansas City, Kan.

Top team honors overall were awarded to the University of Illinois for their combined score of 4,691 points out of a possible 5,000. Students on the team were Brad Faber, Sublette, Ill.; Brian Postin, Lewistown, Ill.; Brock Tarr, Newton, Ill.; Adam Swigart, Farmer City, Ill.; and Carrie Bertelsen, Little York, Ill. The team was coached by Dan Shike.

Other teams placing in the top five in the team competition included Texas Tech

University, second; Iowa State University, third; Michigan State University, fourth; and Oklahoma State University, fifth.

The top five high-scoring individuals in the contest were also recognized for their accomplishments. They included Jason Byrd, Fort Sumner, N.M., first; Michael Lash, Allerton, Iowa, second; Andy VanAernam, Exira, Iowa, third; Carrie Bertelsen, Little York, Ill., fourth; and Nolan Frantz, Hillsboro, Kan., fifth.
