Angus enthusiasts led 196 entries at the 2003 American Royal Super-Point Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show Oct. 27 in Kansas City, Mo. Dean Janssen, Bartonville, Ill., evaluated the 135 females, 57 bulls and four cow-calf pairs before selecting champions.

LaGrand Roth Cruiser 253 claimed the grand champion bull title after first topping the junior division. LaGrand Angus Ranch, Freeman, S.D., and Masters Cattle Co., Bashaw, Alta., Canada, own the January 2002 son of Maple Lane Forever Ready 850.

BC Marathon 7022 captured reserve grand champion bull. Kyle Conley, Clarksdale, Mo., and Holly Gamble, Clinton, Tenn., own the July 2002 son of OCC Kirby

633K. He first won intermediate champion bull.
