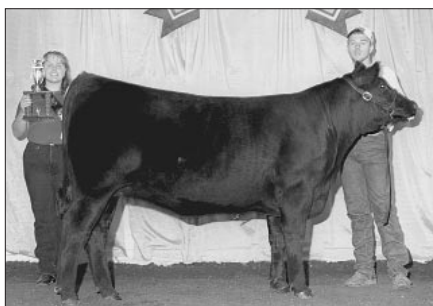

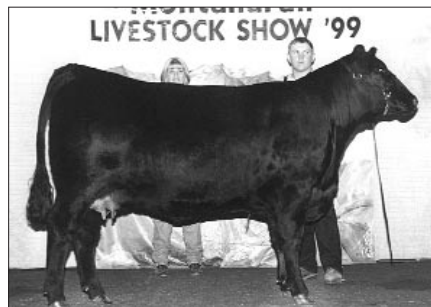

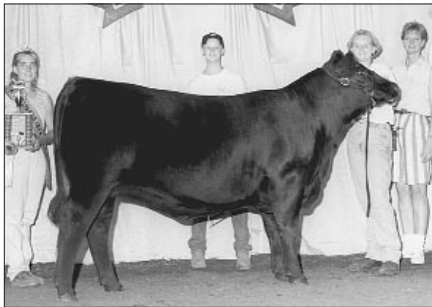

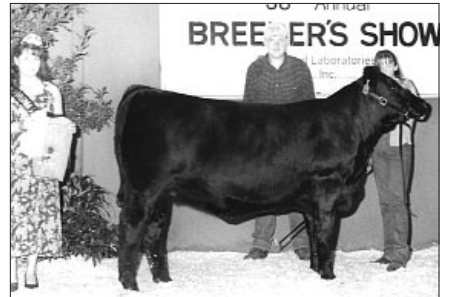

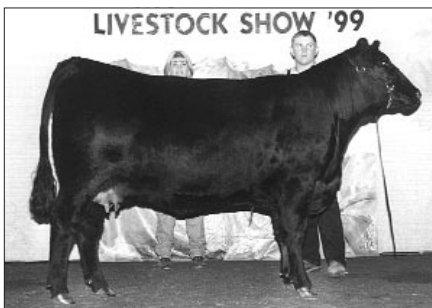

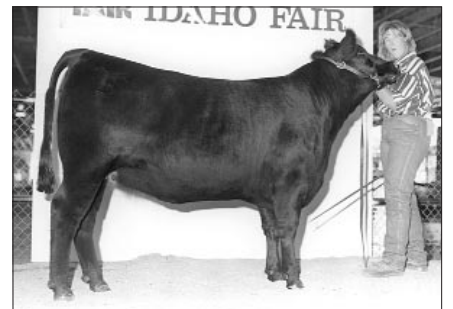

2000 National Junior Angus Show Making Tracks to the New Millennium

Angus enthusiasts from across the nation will be "Tracking the Millennium," when they meet in Des Moines, Iowa, for the 2000 National Junior Angus Show (NJAS). The Iowa Junior Angus Association and the Iowa Angus Association are preparing for the event, which will take place July 10-15, 2000, at the Iowa State Fairgrounds.

More than 1,500 entries are expected for the annual event, which is the largest single-breed beef cattle show in the world. In addition to the cattle show, educational contests and competitions are held. The

National Junior Angus Association (NJAA) elects six individuals to the Junior Board, and junior Angus showmen compete for the coveted title of "Top Showman" during the week-long event.

"We are very excited about heading into the next millennium with our national Junior show in Iowa," says James Fisher, director of junior activities. "The National Junior Angus Show is a great family event and includes a variety of contests to suit everyone's talents."

During the week, junior Angus members

can participate in the American Angus Auxiliary's *Certified Angus Beef*™ Cook-Off, extemporaneous and prepared public speaking contests, and a team sales competition. Other events include poster, photography and graphic design contests.
