

# KR Queen 8213 Named Foundation Heifer

*Foundation Heifer Package for the National Western Stock Show (NWSS) Angus Bull Sale is sure to impress buyers and onlookers alike. Get out your pocketbooks for an outstanding offering coming in January.*

Krebs Ranch, Gordon, Neb., is donating KR Queen 8213 for this year's Angus Foundation Heifer Package. This annual lot featured at the NWSS Angus Bull Sale generates unrestricted funds to support the mission of the Angus Foundation.

"We are honored and thankful for the support of Krebs Ranch to donate this year's female for the Angus Foundation Heifer Package," says Milford Jenkins, Angus Foundation president. "This one-of-a-kind heifer is truly special, and her sale proceeds will do so much for the Foundation's efforts. As well as for the genetics of the Angus program that buys her."

## Elite produces elite

The only female ever produced by Krebs Ranch from the mating of Barstow Queen W16 and Basin Payweight 1682, this heifer is the only embryo heifer leaving the ranch in 2018. Barstow Queen W16 was the top-selling bred lot of the 2017 NWSS Foundation Female Sale, topping out at \$40,000.



This heifer is also a maternal sibling to Barstow Cash, the leading bull for semen sales at Krebs Ranch. Valued at \$324,000 as a herd sire, his progeny continue to dominate the Angus breed in calving ease, performance and phenotype.

Krebs Ranch will feature a full brother to KR Queen 8213 "In the Yards" as part of the ranch's display.

"Elite phenotypic and genetic quality were Eldon and Louisa Krebs' top priorities when choosing a heifer, insisting that the donated female add significant value to the program of the winning bidder," says Jake Scott, Krebs Ranch marketing and customer relations representative.

## But wait, there's more

Set to sell on Jan. 16, 2019, in Denver, Colo., the Foundation Heifer Package includes more than just the elite female from Krebs Ranch.

The American Live Stock Insurance Co. out of Geneva, Ill., is offering 30 days of free insurance to the high bidder, and transportation of the heifer will be provided by Lathrop Livestock Transportation based out of Dundee, Ill.

Trans Ova Genetics, Sioux Center, Iowa, is also offering a unique add-on to the package. Perfect for any farm or ranch looking to advance the herd, this Advanced Reproductive Technology Package consists of one in-vitro fertilization (IVF) cycle using reverse-sorted semen (frozen semen is thawed, then sorted for desired gender). This is accompanied by five fresh transfers into recipients owned by Trans Ova Genetics or client-owned recipients. Also included is one genetic preservation (the first step in the cloning process).

"The winning bidder will walk home with more than just the Package," Jenkins adds. "They also receive the intrinsic reward of investing in the mission of the Foundation. That is priceless."
