Illinois State Fair ROV

Angus enthusiasts led 63 entries at the Illinois State Fair Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show Aug. 14 in Springfield. Willie Weis, Stacyville, Iowa, evaluated the 48 females, 14 bulls and one cow-calf pair before selecting champions.

Hoffman Flint 209 claimed grand champion bull honors after first winning junior champion. Chad Hoffman, Colfax, owns the April 2022 son of PVF Marvel 9185.

JAF 4 You 2 Envy 26 was named reserve grand champion bull.

Anna Johnson, Durand, owns the November 2022 son of SCC SCH 24 Karat 838 that first won senior calf champion.

Paige Lemenager, Hudson, captured grand champion female honors with Lemenager Proven Queen K24. The June 2022 daughter of PVF Marvel 9185 first won intermediate champion.

Brenna Bartlow, Monticello, led the reserve grand champion female. UDE Blackbird 2002 is a January 2022 daughter of SCC SCH 24 Karat

838. She first won junior champion.

Adam Stuckemeyer, Altamont, showed the grand champion cow-calf pair. Kramer's Erica 762 is an April 2017 daughter of KR Joe Canada 4252. A March 2023 heifer calf sired by Kramer's Profile 154 completes the winning pair.

Cody York, Palestine, won premier herdsman award.
