## 2022 Angus Foundation Heifer Pick and Oklahoma Stars

From the very origins of the Angus Foundation, one constant has remained: remarkable generosity.

In 1980, A. F. Flint & Sons, Bard, N.M., donated the first heifer to be sold to Jim Baldridge, North Platte, Neb., for the Angus Foundation during the National Western Stock Show. The proceeds from this sale were the spark leading to the establishment of the Angus Foundation.

Each year, Angus breeders have generously stepped up and donated the best of their herds, and Angus breeders have generously purchased remarkable heifers in support of the Angus Foundation's mission of youth, education and research.

Through the years the fire of mission impact has spread from that spark four decades ago. It has resulted in the Angus Foundation, which funds a wide variety of programs such as Leaders Engaged in Angus Development (LEAD), Raising the Bar, the National Junior Angus Board (NJAB), Beef Leaders Institute (BLI), research and more than \$250,000 in scholarships that are awarded annually.

The 2022 Angus Foundation Heifer Pick is offered by the storied Borror

family of Tehama Angus. Their ranch has been a pioneer of California Angus, being the first in the state to have a bull sale, and a catalyst for driving the use of registered Angus bulls across the Golden State.

The heifer pick is the buyer's choice of one of five of their best bred heifers from Tehama's Fall 2020 calf crop. The 2022 heifer pick will be sold at the National Angus Bull Sale Friday, Jan 7, 2022, at the Cattlemen's Congress in Oklahoma City, Okla.
