Angus enthusiasts led 116 entries at the 2003 American Angus Breeders' Futurity Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show July 12 in Louisville, Ky. David Brown, Idaho Falls, Idaho, evaluated the 81 females, 29 bulls and six cowcalf pairs before picking the champions.

Wesley Womack, Pembroke, Ky., was named the Herdsman of the Year.






