ngus producers competed for top honors during the 2009 National Western Stock Show (NWSS) Angus Carload & Pen Show Jan. 17 in Denver, Colo. Three carloads and 31 pens-of-three were showcased in the Yards during the 103rd NWSS. Rance Long, Big Cabin, Okla.; Jim Pipkin, Republic, Mo.; and Larry Rice, Scottsbluff, Neb., evaluated the bulls and selected champions.

Express Angus Ranches, Yukon, Okla., claimed the grand champion carload banner. The 10 January and February 2008 bulls

were sired by EXAR 263C, Stevenson Moneymaker R185, Rito 1I2 of 2536 Rito 6I6, Quaker Hill Objective 3J15 and BC 7022 Raven 7965. The group weighed an average of 1,410 pounds (lb.), posted an average scrotal circumference of 40.3 centimeters (cm), an average rump fat thickness of 0.50 inches (in.), and an average rib fat thickness of 0.47 in.

Whitestone-Krebs, Gordon, Neb., exhibited the reserve grand champion carload with January and February 2008 sons of SAV Net Worth 4200, WK Vegas, TC One Way 618, Stevenson Moneymaker R185 and GT Shear Force. The 10 bulls posted an average weight of 1,340 lb., an average rump fat thickness of 0.48 in., an average rib fat thickness of 0.42 in. and an average scrotal circumference of 39.90 cm.

Limestone LLC, Perkins, Okla., showcased the grand champion pen of three with January and February 2008 sons of BC Marathon 7022 and BC 7022 Raven 7965. The trio posted an average weight of 1,330 lb., an average rump fat thickness of 0.47 in., an average rib fat thickness of 0.39 in., and

an average scrotal circumference of 39.2 cm. The bulls first won early calf champion pen of three.

Oklahoma State University, Stillwater, Okla., captured the reserve grand champion pen of three title after first winning late calf champion pen. The March 2008 trio sired by Stevenson Moneymaker R185 posted an average weight of 1,208 lb., an average rump fat thickness of 0.53 in., an average rib fat thickness of 0.44 in., and an average scrotal circumference of 38.2 cm.
