LSU Beef Bull Evaluation Test

112-day final report (Feb. 14)

The 97th Louisiana State University (LSU) Beef Bull Evaluation Test began Oct. 25, 2006. Fifty-one bulls representing five breeds and 13 breeders completed the test. Thirty-seven bulls are Angus. The cattle were grouped in 10 pens. Weights were taken at 28-day intervals for the 112-day test. Several bulls were treated for coccidiosis. All bulls were treated with Cydectin® Oct. 25 and Dec. 20, 2006. The LSU performance ratio is calculated as the average of the 365-day adjusted yearling weight ratio and the average daily gain (ADG) ratio.

The 45th Annual Midland Bull Test currently has 1,186 bulls on test, including 703 Angus, 190 Red Angus, 90 South Devon, 88 Salers, 59 Gelbvieh, 34 Charolais, eight Simmental, six Shorthorn, three Maine Anjou, two Braunvieh, two Murray Grey and one Limousin.

The bulls arrived for test in October 2006 and underwent a two-week conditioning period before starting the test. They are being fed a ration that is more than 80% roughage, with the grain including whole oats.

There are 52 bulls in the 33rd Annual Southeast Colorado Bull Test. Breeds represented include Angus, Brangus, Salers, Polled Hereford, and Composite or Crossbred who have a predominance of one breed but are not eligible for registry in a breed association.

The bulls are being fed a moderate-energy growing ration designed to develop them for use as yearlings. This ration allows the bulls to express their genetic potential for feedlot traits, but is not designed for maximum gain.

Overall weights for the 77-day period were lower than previous weights due to severe winter storms and extremely cold temperatures.

Bulls born between Jan. 1 and April 15, 2006, went on test for the Pennsylvania Performance Bull Testing Program Oct. 31, 2006. Producers from Pennsylvania, Maryland, New York, West Virginia and New Jersey started 138 bulls participating in the 112-day performance-testing program. Seven breeds participated in this year's program, with Angus representing more than 60% of the bulls. At the conclusion of the test, there were 84 Angus, 18 Simmental, 10 Red Angus, eight Hereford, five Charolais, three Limousin, one Gelbvieh and one Crossbred bulls.
