Edisto Forage Bull Test Blackville, S.C.

Following are two weight reports for the Edisto Forage Bull Test being conducted at the Edisto Research & Education Center, Blackville, S.C.

112-day report (March 6)

There was not an overabundance of winter grazing in the 28 days preceding the 112-day weigh point of the Edisto Forage Bull Test, reports Lary Olson, Extension animal scientist and bull test coordinator. The bulls gained an average of 2.8 pounds (lb.) per day during the 28-day period.

Southeast Colorado Bull Test Holly

112-day final report (March 12)

Fifty-two bulls were weighed off test for the 33rd Annual Southeast Colorado Bull Test. Breeds represented include Angus, Brangus, Salers, Polled Hereford, and Composite or Crossbred who have a predominance of one breed but are not eligible for registry in a breed association.

The bulls were fed a moderate-energy growing ration designed to develop them for use as yearlings. This ration allows the bulls to express their genetic potential for feedlot traits, but is not designed for maximum gain.

Feed conversions are higher than normal due to weather conditions since the beginning of 2007, notes Bruce Fickenscher, Colorado State University (CSU) Extension specialist/Southeast area.

The 45th Annual Midland Bull Test featured 1,186 bulls, including 703 Angus, 190 Red Angus, 90 South Devon, 88 Salers, 59 Gelbvieh, 34 Charolais, eight Simmental, six Shorthorn, three Maine Anjou, two Braunvieh, two Murray Grey and one Limousin. The bulls arrived for test in October 2006 and underwent a two-week conditioning period before starting the test. They were fed a ration of more than 80% roughage.

LSU test to begin May 21

The next Louisiana State University (LSU) performance test for bull calves at the Dean Lee Research Station Livestock Testing Station at Alexandria, La., is scheduled to begin May 21. The test offers producers the opportunity to identify young bulls with the ability to gain weight rapidly for possible selection as future herd sires.

To be eligible, bulls born Sept. 1-Nov. 30, 2006, must be registered as a purebred (a copy of the registration paper is required).

Percentage bulls will be accepted if there is sufficient space. Priority will be given to bulls nominated by Louisiana breeders. Bulls nominated by out-of-state breeders will be accepted if space is available.

Bulls must meet all health regulations, including an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health papers). All bulls must have tested negative for persistent infection (PI) with bovine viral diarrhea (BVD). Bulls no longer have to be tested for brucellosis (Bang's disease).

Bulls must weigh at least 2.2 lb. per day of age at delivery. Birth and weaning weights of all calves are requested and strongly

recommended. Bulls must be structurally sound and have a legible tattoo or brand. Bull calves should be above herd average for weaning weight, quality and conformation. They should be weaned at least three weeks prior to delivery to the station.

The cost to test a bull includes a \$100 nomination fee per bull plus 90¢ per lb. of gain during the 112-day test. The average cost will be approximately \$450 per bull.
