Cooking contest

It is also the time for National Junior Angus Association (NJAA) members to organize teams and select recipes for the 2008 Auxiliary-sponsored All-American *Certified Angus Beef* Cook-Off in Des Moines, Iowa, at the National Junior Angus Show (NJAS) in July. The Cook-Off is sponsored by the American Angus Auxiliary, the NJAA and Certified Angus Beef LLC (CAB). Several Angus breeders and supporters have also generously pledged dollars for awards and special items to celebrate the 25th anniversary.

Bill Werner, Werner Angus, Cordova, Ill., will be sponsoring custom-designed T-shirts; Anne Patton Schubert, Taylorsville, Ky., and Ardyce O'Neill, Logan, Iowa, the co-founders of the Cook-Off, are sponsoring 25th anniversary

commemorative pins; and many other breeders will be sponsoring various awards.

In addition, the Pat Grote LEAD Award will be presented to the winning team members in the intermediate division of the fresh meat competition. This award/scholarship covers the registration cost for the Leaders Engaged in Angus Development (LEAD) Conference hosted by the NJAA. This year's LEAD Conference will be Aug. 1-4 in Billings, Mont.

The highest-placing team in the Cook-Off overall will be awarded the prestigious Black Kettle Award in memory of Paul St. Blanc.

The Cook-Off is an educational and fun team event. Participants creatively provide education about CAB in a skit format while cooking a CAB product. A

panel of judges critiques the Cook-Off entries. The Cook-Off contest will be Tuesday, July 15, beginning at 1 p.m.



There are three age divisions for junior members, plus an adult division. This year a special alumni division will also be offered for anyone who participated in the first Cook-Off in 1983 in Des Moines. Each state is allowed one team per category, per age division. Teams can be composed of two to six people.

If your state has never participated in the Cook-Off, please don't hesitate to contact the committee chairpersons or any of the officers to obtain more information and suggestions for the contest. Anyone who participates or coaches a team learns a tremendous amount about CAB, which will help them to promote our outstanding product, while they are having a fun time giving their presentation or skit.

Our chairpersons for the Cook-Off are Schubert and Anne Lampe, Scott City, Kan. Entry forms and guidelines can be obtained from Schubert at 502-477-2663. Recipes and names, addresses and ages of participants in the Cook-Off need to be submitted to Schubert by June 1. Check out the NJAA web site for more information about the contest.


Meetings
