Angus enthusiasts endured the summer humidity of Missouri to compete in the 2004 Angus Foundation Golf Tournament, hosted July 13 at Shiloh Springs Golf Club in Platte City, Mo. The fourth annual event took place during the National Junior Angus Show (NJAS) in Kansas City, Mo. Fifty-six golfers played in this year's tournament, with proceeds going to the Angus Foundation, which supports youth, education and research.

"The weather was a little warm, but all had a fun time," says Milford Jenkins, director of development for the Angus Foundation. "We had a record number of golf players, and a record income of almost \$20,000 was raised at the tournament."

"I encourage everyone to bring their clubs to the 'Mile High City' in 2005."
