# Juniors Compete in Atlantic National

Angus champions named at 2017 Atlantic National Regional Jr. Angus Preview Show.

Young Angus exhibitors from across the country exhibited 178 entries at the 2017 Atlantic National Regional Preview Jr. Angus Show May 26-27 in Timonium, Md. Chris Mullinix, Manhattan, Kan., evaluated the 33 bred-and-owned (B&O) females, 115 owned females, five cow-calf pairs, 11 B&O bulls and 14 steers before selecting champions.

Brody Fitzgerald, West Grove, Pa., led the grand champion B&O female. Cherry Knoll Lady 1481 is a November 2014 daughter of Dameron First Class. She first won senior champion. Cherry Knoll May 1672 captured reserve grand champion B&O female for Bryce Fitzgerald, West Grove, Pa. The July 2016 daughter of SAV Brilliance 8077 first won summer calf champion.

Kallie Knott, Laotto, Ind., led the grand champion owned female, SSF Lady Impression O265. The October 2015 daughter of Dameron First Impression first won senior calf champion. PVF Proven Queen 5250 won reserve grand champion owned female honors. Korey Moser, Larchwood, Iowa, owns the September 2015 daughter of C&C McKinley 3000 EXAR that first won reserve senior calf champion.

Allison Davis, Shelbyville, Tenn., led the grand champion owned cow-calf pair. AED Rita 328A is a December 2013 daughter of Connealy Final Product. A November 2016 heifer calf sired by SAC Conversation completes the winning pair. Destiny's Lady M12 won reserve grand champion owned cow-calf pair. Morgan Hutchins, Charleston, Ill., owns the March 2013 daughter of SAV Avenger of 9969. A March 2017 heifer calf sired by Destiny's Sound 38 is at side.
