

Illinois Jr. Field Day

Winners chosen at Illinois Jr. Field Day.

Illinois junior Angus members led 170 entries at the 2016 Illinois Junior Angus Association Field Day June 4 in Bloomington. Lydell Meier, Clinton, Tenn., evaluated six cow-calf pairs, 47 bred-and-owned (B&O) females, 93 owned females, nine B&O bulls, and 15 steers before choosing champions.

Olivia Wilson, Ogden, led the supreme champion and grand champion cow-calf pair. WCC Forever Lady B4 is a January 2014 daughter of SAV Brilliance 8077. Her calf is a March 2016 bull sired by Connealy Final Product. PVF Proven Queen 2162 won reserve grand champion cow-calf pair. Troy Rawlings, New Holland, owns the September 2012 daughter of PVF Insight 0129. A December 2015 heifer calf sired by PVF Spinoff 3001 is at side.
