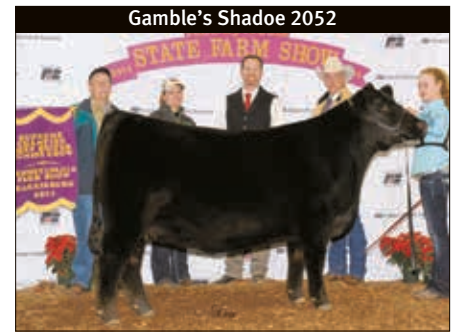
### ▣ Pennsylvania Farm Show Jr. Angus Show
