Angus Champions Named at 2005 North American ROV Show

North American International Livestock Exposition Roll of Victory Angus Show

Nov. 14-15 • Louisville, Ky. • No. entries: 238

Angus enthusiasts led 238 entries while competing for top honors at the 2005 North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE) Super-Point Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show, Nov. 14-15, 2005, in Louisville, Ky. Jack Ward, Plattsburg, Mo., evaluated the 180 females, 52 bulls and six cow-calf pairs.

QLC LaGrand Forum claimed grand champion and senior champion bull honors. Quirk Land & Cattle Co., Hastings, Neb.; LaGrand Angus & Hereford Ranch, Freeman, S.D.; and Fluharty Farms LLC, Gause, Texas, own the March 2003 son of G13 Structure.

EXAR Pit Boss 409 won reserve grand champion bull for Jim Mattes, O'Neals, Calif., and Express Angus Ranches, Shawnee, Okla. The January 2004 son of EXAR Sudden Impact 1537 first won junior champion.

Gamble's Shadoe 988 captured grand champion female honors for Jessica Willis, Union Bridge, Md. The September 2004 daughter of Gamble's Hot Rod first won senior calf champion.

Boyd Forever Lady 4004 claimed the reserve grand champion female and junior champion titles. Blake Boyd, Mayslick, Ky., owns the January 2004 daughter of BR Midland.

WCC Blackcap N173 won grand champion cow-calf pair. Wilson Cattle Co., Cloverdale, Ind., and Mark Fort, Knightstown, Ind., own the April 2003 daughter of Vermilion Dateline 7078. A February 2005 daughter of WCC Special Design L309 was at side.

Michael Murphy, Jefferson, Iowa, showed the reserve grand champion cow-calf pair. LaGrand Lady Echo 3497 is a February 2003 daughter of Famous 7001. A February 2005 son of LaGrand Designer H314 is at side.

Wilson Cattle Co. and McCurry Bros., Sedgwick, Kan., won both the get-of-sire and junior get-of-sire classes with progeny of WCC Special Design L309. Express Angus Ranches won breeder's best six head.

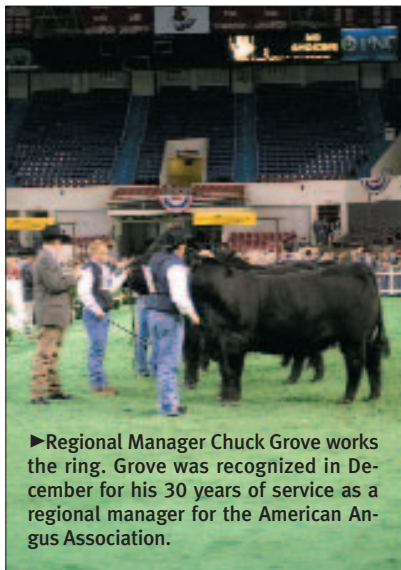
