Rechargeable spotlight with green lens

Larson Electronics has unveiled a green 35-watt HID handheld spotlight with an optional 7- or 5-inch (in.) lens. The RL-85-HID-Green is a lightweight, ergonomic handheld spotlight that operates on 12 or 24 volts DV via a 16-foot (ft.) coil cord ending

in a cigarette plug. The unique reflector and lens configuration produces a 1,900-ft. beam in spotlight mode, making it approximately a 15-million retail candlepower rating.

are made from high-impact nylon, and the polycarbonate lamp housing is thick and contoured for extra support. The 35-watt HID bulb in the unit is rated at 4,500 hours of operational life and produces 3,200 lumens of light. An included rechargeable lithium ion battery pack provides more than two hours of runtime.

The position of the bulb and the shape of the reflector are different than most handheld lighting products, as it is designed to capture and focus 90% of the light being emitted. By lifting a locking tab located behind the lamp housing, the operator can rotate the lamp housing, which enables the operator to adjust the beam from a wide, soft flood pattern to a tight, spot beam that goes out to 1,900 ft.

The spotlight weighs only 3 pounds (lb.) and 6 ounces (oz.).

Redesigned tractors

Mahindra dealers nationwide are now showcasing the new Mahindra USA 1500 series tractors that feature the uniquely designed Tier IV solution, the Mahindra Common Rail Diesel (mCRD) technology.

Key features include a high-pressure fuel injection engine that greatly reduces visible engine smoke; multiple injection points for fuel efficiency with greener emissions, including a reduction in NOx and particulate matter (PM); no exhaust filter, which means less maintenance and no operator involvement; a reduction of gas emissions by more than 360 tons per year; a diesel oxidation catalyst (DOC) after-treatment system that does not require regeneration; and a high-efficiency positive crankcase ventilation (PCV) technology to capture and clean gases from the combustion chamber before releasing them into the environment.

These 35 hp to 39 hp tractors are suited for small agricultural jobs at all sized organizations. The 1550 series model includes the 1533 (34.5 hp) open station with optional 8×8 synchronized shuttle or three-range hydrostatic transmission. The 1538 (38.7 hp) is available in an open station model with choice of transmission or cab model with three-range hydrostatic transmission.

Highlights of the 1500 series, available in several configurations, are a heavier built-in weight that provides better stability and traction; an engine that operates at a lower rpm for less noise and lower fuel consumption; better torque due to 50%-83% more cubic inch displacement; a wet sleeve, heavy-duty rebuildable engine due to mCRD technology; 32% more three-point hitch capacity; enhanced operator comfort with a flat platform, a rubber floor mat, tiltable power steering and a simple-to-operate ergonomic joystick; and a two-lever bucket removal for quick and easy attachment changes.
