## Probiotics

## Portable tank light

Larson Electronics has announced the release of an explosion-proof LED tank light mounted to a portable wheelbarrow cart. The new EPL-18C-150LED-RT produces a brilliant flood pattern of light that is ideal for illuminating enclosed areas and further adds to this unit's desirability as a portable tank lighting solution.

The light is rated Class 1 & 2 Division 1 & 2 and is a cart-mounted explosion-proof LED light that

provides 10,000 square feet (sq. ft.) of work area coverage while producing 12,000 lumens of light from 150 watts. The portable light has a removable light head measuring 16 inches (in.) wide by 14 in. tall. The portability combined with the 360° of rotation and 90° of tilt offered by the LED light head provides an effective alternative to often cumbersome explosion-proof string lights.

Included with the light and cart is 250 ft. of SOOW cord terminated in an explosion-proof plug. This unit is multi-voltage capable and is configured to operate on a range from 120 to 277 volts 50/60 Hz. Twenty-five peel-off mylar overspray lamp protectors provide the lamp protection from dirt or debris and can be removed, cleaned and replaced, lessening the need for tedious lamp cleaning or replacements. The lamp is T5 temperature rated and the LED light head retains 80% of its lumen output after 50,000 hours of use, far longer than incandescent or fluorescent lamps.
