On-test report (Oct. 11, 2008)

The 57th Annual Beef Bull Performance Test at Panhandle State University, Goodwell, Okla., is under way once again. The bulls consigned to the test this year were officially weighed on test Oct. 11. There are 101 bulls consigned to the test, representing three beef breeds — Angus, Hereford and Maine-Anjou. Seventeen cooperators from Oklahoma, Kansas, Nebraska and Texas have bulls on test this year.

The test covers a period of 112 days, during which data will be collected on each bull's average daily gain (ADG), weight-per-day of age (WDA), frame score, scrotal circumference (SC), fat thickness, ribeye area (REA) and marbling score. Feed efficiency is measured on a pen basis. The bulls are fed a growing ration consisting of rolled corn, rolled oats, chopped alfalfa, dry distillers' grain (DDG), cottonseed hulls, molasses and protein supplement. Performance summaries will be reported at 28-day intervals during the test.

University of Tennessee Bull Test Middle Tennessee Research & Education Center, Spring Hill, Tenn.

The University of Tennessee Senior Bull Test weighed 89 Angus for the 56-day report at the Middle Tennessee Research and Education Center in Spring Hill Nov. 11. Sixty-three junior Angus bulls were weighed on test Nov. 11. The 84-day tests are standard, impartial postweaning gain tests for registered bulls of any recognized beef breed or three-quarter-blood or higherpercentage bulls of breeds that have an open herd book. The senior bull test is for bulls born Sept. 1-Dec. 15, 2007. Junior bulls must have been born Dec. 16, 2007-March 15, 2008. Off-test weights will be collected as an average of weights taken Dec. 1 and Dec. 2. Qualifying bulls will sell Jan. 22, 2009, at the Middle Tennessee Research and Education Center.

The 34th Annual Performance Tested Bull Test at Southern Illinois University Carbondale (SIUC) is under way. Forty bulls representing breeders in two states were weighed on test Oct. 22-23. The bulls were scheduled to be re-weighed Nov. 20.

Bulls will be fed Purina's Impact Grower mix using intake modifier technology. The development diet will be fed for 112 days free choice. This diet consists of 12.5% crude protein (CP). Rumensin® and Tylan are added. Corn will be rolled or cracked.

Florida Bull Test

The Florida Bull Test is under way with 65 bulls on feed at the University of Florida's (UF) North Florida Research and Education Center near Marianna, Fla. There are 40 Angus bulls, two Charolais, three Limflex, one Santa Gertrudis, seven SimAngus and 12 Simmental currently on test. These bulls were all born Aug.-Dec. 2007.

The bulls were delivered in September and have been on full feed for comparison since Sept. 2-3. The 84-day test will conclude Dec. 9-10.

In previous years, the Florida Bull Test had been a 112-day full-feed test, but due to rising feed prices, the test was shortened to keep consignment costs from rising.

For the first 28 days of the test, ADG averaged 3.12 lb., ranging from 5.29 lb. to -2.30 lb. Only two bulls had negative gains, likely because of sickness or injury. The test sale is scheduled for Jan. 10, 2009.

WCA/WSU Bull Test

One hundred three bulls owned by 38 breeders from three states were weighed on test Nov. 4-5 at the Washington State University (WSU) Irrigated Agriculture Research and Extension Center in Prosser, Wash. The 16th annual all-breed test, jointly sponsored by the Washington Cattlemen's Association (WCA) and WSU, includes 65 Angus bulls, eight Red Angus, seven Simmental, six SimAngus, six Horned Hereford, six Polled Hereford and five Gelbvieh.

Bulls are preconditioned at the ranch by their owners and receive a series of booster shots upon arrival to minimize health problems. Test bulls are started on mostly chopped hay and a small amount of concentrate gradually added during the three-week pretest warm-up period. Once the 120-day test begins, corn silage replaces half of the hay on a dry weight basis to produce a diet similar to feedlot growing ration, which allows bulls to express their individual genetic potential for both growth and carcass merit. Once the bulls come off test, the grain is removed from the ration. Bulls harden up on an all-roughage ration and are ready to breed cows for their new owners following the March 25, 2009, sale at the research center. A presale social with a nationally recognized speaker is planned for the night before.
