

Pennsylvania Bull Testing Program Pennsylvania Furnace, Pa. 112-day final report (Feb. 17)

Beef producers from Connecticut, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and West Virginia consigned 120 bulls to the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's 2008-2009 performance bull test at the Samuel E. Hayes Jr. Livestock Evaluation Center at Pennsylvania Furnace. The winter test is a 112-day performance test for bulls born Jan. 1-April 15, 2008.

The bulls are evaluated, compared and indexed on average daily gain (ADG), weight per day of age (WDA), feed efficiency, loin-eye area, fat thickness and meat quality traits.

Seven beef breeds are participating in this year's test, including 66 Angus, 20 Simmentals, 13 Herefords, eight Red Angus, four Limousin, five Charolais and one crossbred.

2009 IBEP Summer Test

The entry deadline for the 2009 IBEP

Summer Test is April 6. Bulls born May 1-Oct. 31, 2008, are eligible, including nonrecorded and composite breed bulls. Each bull's WDA must be at least 2.25 lb. when delivered on April 28.

The 125-day performance test begins May 19 and ends Sept. 21, 2009. The 64th IBEP Bull Sale will be Oct. 17 at the Springville Feeder Auction and will follow the Bred Heifer Sale sponsored by the Springville Feeder Auction Association. Heifers will sell at 2 p.m.

Bulls that are suspected to be carriers of a lethal allele (as defined by their breed association) for which a DNA test is available must be DNA-tested and verified free of the lethal allele prior to entry in a test. Lethal traits with available DNA testing include: arthrogryposis multiplex (AM) in Angus, tibial hemimelia (TH) in Shorthorn and other breeds. Consult with your breed association for a complete list of known lethal alleles and DNA testing procedures.

Bulls will be fed a total mixed ration consisting of approximately 55% corn silage, 22% corn grain, 20% dried distillers' grains with solubles, and 3% balancer. Salt and minerals will be provided free-choice.
