Midland Bull Test Columbus, Mont. final report (Group 1 Feb. 8, Group 2 March 1)

The Midland Bull test was a 120-day gain test with a 70-day efficiency test. Bulls were fed a 44-Mcal diet that was high in roughage for targeted gains of about 3 lb. per day. There were 612 Angus bulls weighed on test. The first efficiency test group was weighed on test Oct. 8, 2011. The second efficiency test group was weighed on test Nov. 5, 2011.

LFTB discussion affects beef prices

The publicity about lean, finely textured beef (LFTB) and the unappealing new nickname associated with it is having a big effect on beef prices. The price spread between 90% lean fresh beef trimmings and 50% lean trimmings during the last week of March was a record \$134.77 per hundredweight (cwt.). Fresh 90% lean trimmings averaged \$217.71 per cwt., and fresh 50% lean trimmings were \$82.94 per cwt. The price spread widened further the first week of April.

The LFTB process has been used for years to remove fat from beef trimmings. The recent adverse publicity from calling the product "pink slime" has caused the value of high-fat beef trimmings to plummet. April 5, fresh 50% lean beef trimmings averaged \$54.80 per cwt. Five weeks previous, these trimmings averaged \$100.66 per cwt.

The beef cutout value was lower again the first week of April for the fifth consecutive week. On the morning of April 6, the Choice boxed beef carcass cutout value was \$177.41 per cwt., down \$6.40 from last week. The select carcass cutout was down \$8.17 from the previous Friday to \$174.98 per hundred pounds of carcass weight. The Choice-Select price spread was \$2.43, up from \$0.65 per cwt. from the week prior.
