168-day off-test report (May 4)

The 60 bulls on the 2010 Edisto Forage Bull Test did well during the past 28 days of the 168-day bull test, reports Larry Olson. Health has been excellent. The bulls, born Jan. 1-March 31, 2009, were turned out on grazing Dec. 4. Their overall average 140-day ADG increased to 3.32 lb. per day and average WDA increased to 2.99 lb. per day.
