63-day report (July 20, 2010)

The 2010 Indiana Bull Evaluation Program (IBEP) Summer Test has 68 bulls, 52 of them Angus, on test from 33 cooperators.

Bulls were weighed on July 20, and their average weight was 1,052 lb. vs. 931 lb. on June 15. Even with the high temperatures this past month, the bulls are doing well. As expected, feed consumption has dropped off in the heat, but bulls are still eating about 2.1% of body weight on a dry-matter basis. Bulls averaged 3.45 lb. daily gain for the 35-day period and 3.93 lb. per day for the 63 days on test. None of the bulls had really poor gains, and the only health issue is persistent warts on a few bulls. All bulls have received two doses of wart vaccine, so, hopefully, those will be clearing up soon.
