

2010 IBEP Summer Test Bedford, Ind.

91-day report (Aug. 18, 2010)

The 2010 Indiana Bull Evaluation Program (IBEP) Summer Test has 68 bulls, 52 of them Angus, on test from 33 cooperators.

Bulls were weighed Aug. 18 and their average weight was 1,148 lb. vs. 1,052 lb. on June 15. Even with the high temperatures the past month, the bulls are doing well. As expected, feed consumption has dropped off in the heat, but bulls are still eating about 1.9% of body weight on a dry-matter basis. Bulls averaged 3.45 lb. daily gain for the 35-day period and 3.78 lb. per day for the 91 days on test. None of the bulls had really poor gains, and the only health issues have been four bulls treated for respiratory issues and persistent warts on a few bulls.

Ted Dyer, Extension animal scientist-beef cattle at the University of Georgia, reports that the bulls have taken off to a great start. Temperatures have been above average, but the bulls' overall health has been great. Three bulls have been removed since delivery due to physical conditions and/or registration requirements.

The overall performance of the bulls has been excellent, with the ADG at 3.13 lb. per
