The 16th HERD program at the Tifton Bull Evaluation Center in Irwinville is under way. The center received 166 heifers Oct. 6. The heifers were worked for the second time Nov. 12. Lee Jones, University of Georgia (UGA) College of Veterinary Medicine, and his team conducted the reproductive tract maturity scores and pelvic area measurements.

Lutalyse was to be injected Dec. 12. All heifers were to be bred Dec. 15 and injected with GnRH. Cleanup bulls were to be placed with the heifers Dec. 23.

Tifton Bull Evaluation Center, Tifton, Ga.
28-day report (Nov. 18, 2014)

The 57th Tifton Bull Evaluation Program began Sept. 29-30 with the delivery of 144 bulls representing nine different breeds and averaging 781 lb. Performance has been excellent, and the health of the bulls has been good, says Jacob Segers, extension animal scientist.

The 112-day test features bulls born Dec. 1, 2012-Feb. 28, 2013. All bulls tested negative for persistent infection with bovine viral diarrhea (PI-BVD).

Going on test Oct. 21, the 71 Angus bulls averaged 879 lb. for a weight per day of age (WDA) of 3.13 lb., while all 143 bulls averaged 867 lb. with a WDA of 3.05 lb. Interim weights will be collected Dec. 16 and Jan. 15, 2015, and final weights are scheduled for collection Feb. 9-10. Qualifying bulls may sell in the test sale March 4.

Bulls were delivered to the Bloomfield and Dunlap test stations for the Iowa Cattlemen's Association (ICA) 2015 Bull Evaluation Program, with spring-born bulls at the test station at the Van Meter Feedyard in Guthrie Center, Iowa, and fall-born bulls at the test station at Kirkwood Community College in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. The Bloomfield test has 30 Angus bulls, the Dunlap test has 17 Angus spring-born bulls, and there are 14 Angus fall-born bulls at Kirkwood. There were 37 spring-born Angus bulls delivered for the Tama test at the Van Meter Feedyard.

The bulls were to complete a 21-day warm-up period following their respective delivery dates. Bulls are to be weighed twice going on test.
