The 14th Calhoun Heifer Evaluation and **Reproductive Development (HERD) Program** officially started with 157 heifers delivered by 25 consignors Dec. 5, 2013. The heifer team along with the crew at the Northwest **Georgia Research and Education Center** processed the heifers.

The first workday was Jan. 2. Estrous synchronization was to begin Jan. 29, and all heifers will be time-bred March 3.

All heifers tested negative for PI-BVD.

WIU Bull Test Macomb. Ill. 28-day report (Nov. 19, 2013)

WBIA Bull Test University of Wisconsin, Platteville, Wis. 37-day report (Jan. 8)

The Wisconsin Beef Improvement Association (WBIA) has conducted and overseen a central performance bull test each year since 1957. Young beef bulls from all over Wisconsin and the Midwest have been delivered to the University of Wisconsin– Platteville farm to develop a performance proof in an unbiased environment designed to let the cream rise to the top. Edisto Forage Bull Test Edisto Research & Education Center, Blackville, S.C. 28-day report (Jan. 14)

The 2014 Edisto Forage Bull Test (EFBT) began Dec. 17, 2013, in Blackville after the delivery of 57 bulls Nov. 25. Scott Sell, area livestock/forage extension agent and bull test coordinator, says that although the last 28 days have been some of the coldest in a decade, the weights look great.
