The 15th Calhoun Heifer Evaluation and Reproductive Development (HERD) Program officially started with 153 heifers delivered by 24 consignors Dec. 4, 2014. Jason Duggin, extension beef specialist, says the health status of the group has been good as a whole.

The first workday was Jan. 6, when they were given booster vaccinations along with hip height and weight measurements. The group was on target with an ADG of 1.6 lb.

The second workday was Jan. 28. At that time all heifers were examined for pelvic area, reproductive tract maturity score (RTMS), disposition and gain. Heifers gaining less than 20 lb. during the 22-day period were measured for elevated rectal temperature as a precaution. CIDR®s were implanted Jan. 28, with removal scheduled for Feb. 11. Lutalyse® was given and weights taken Feb. 27. Heifers were to be time-bred March 2.
